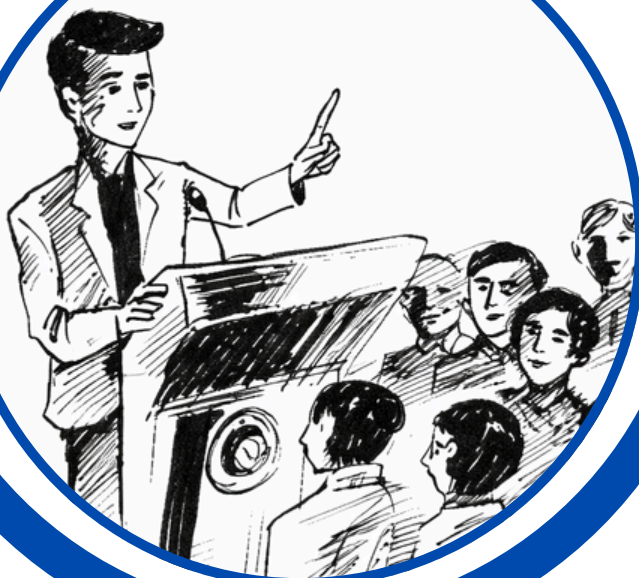

About FORE

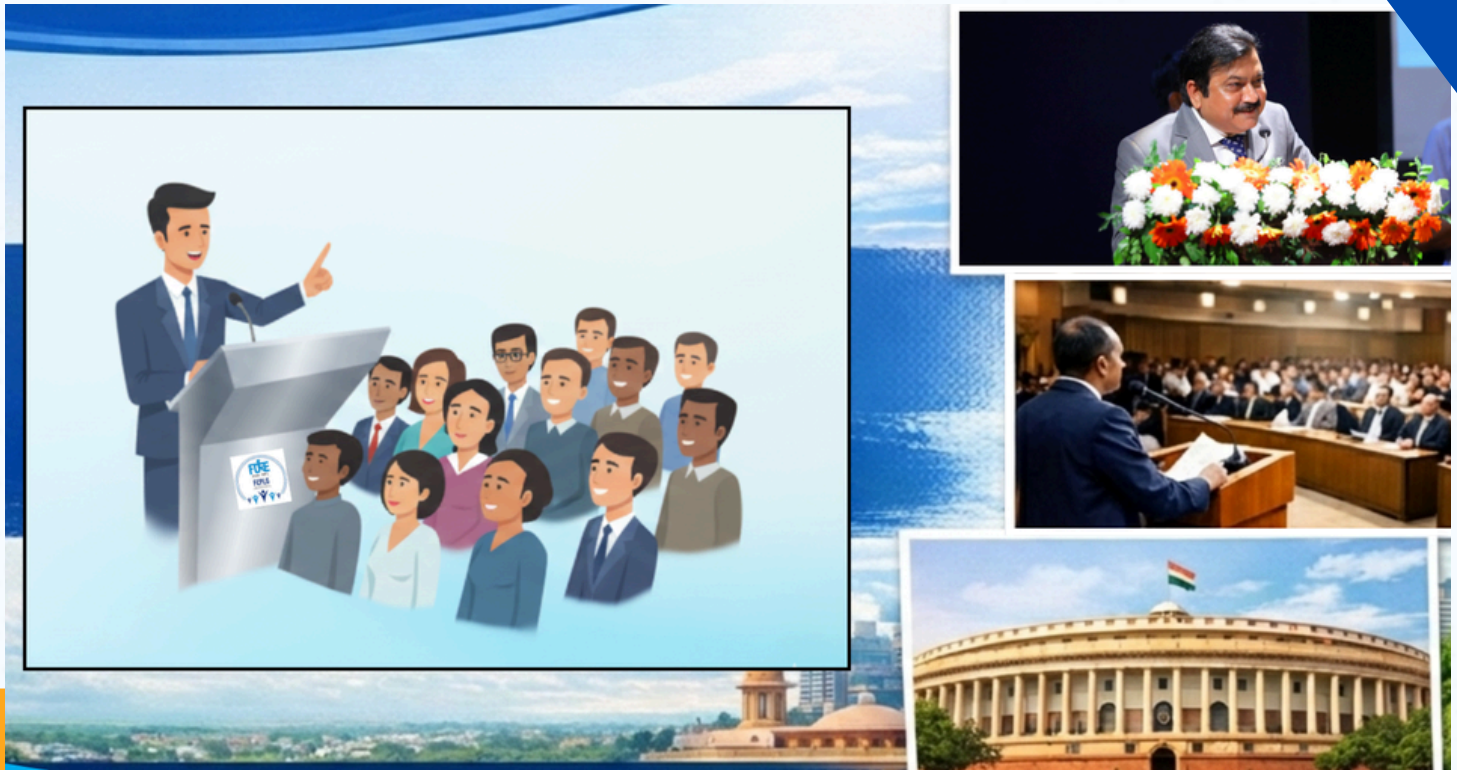

Advocate for women's active participation in politics and governance, providing them with the resources, skills, and platforms to lead and influence policy-making.

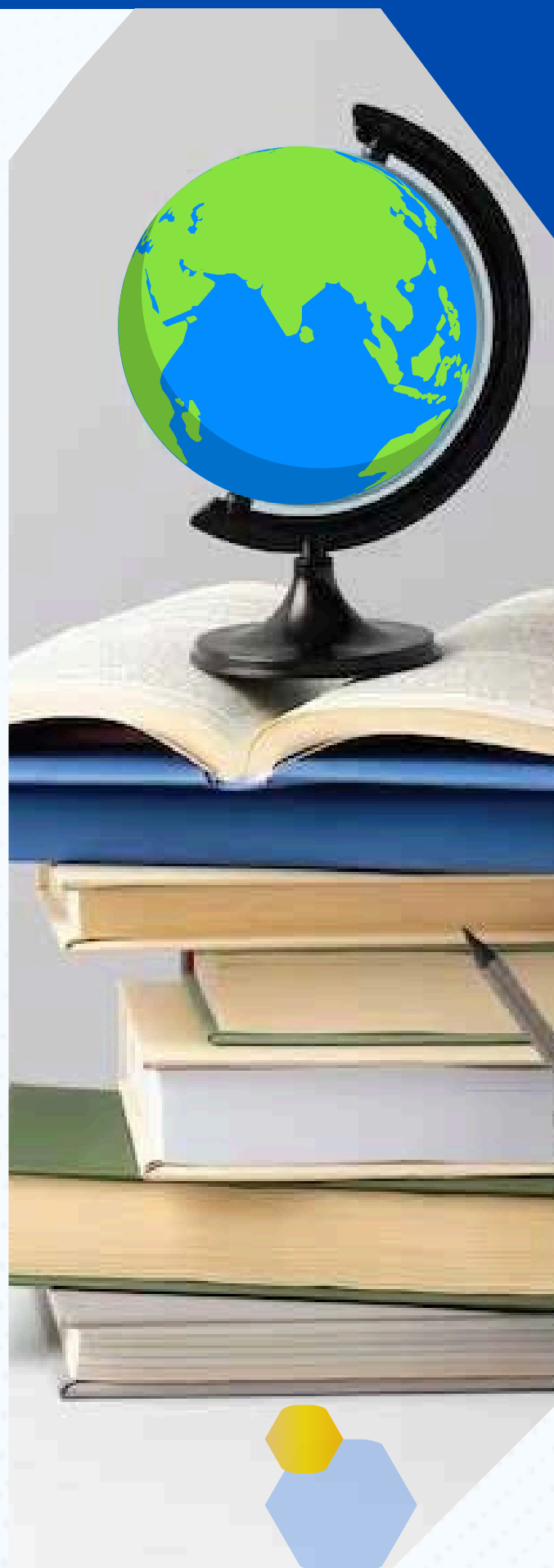
Our Work and Pedagogy
